

Preparation of Abstract for the International Congress on Artificial Intelligence in Medical Sciences

ABSTRACT

The abstract of an article should be clear, concise and accurate summary, having no more than 500 words, and including the explicit sub-headings (headings in bold). It should be single-spaced in 11-point Times New Roman. Use of abbreviations should be avoided and the references should not be cited in the abstract. Ideally, each abstract should include the following sub-headings:

Background and aims: Include one or two sentences to introduce the broad topic area and provide a reason for the study then a clear statement of the study aim. A hypothesis could be included in this section.

Method: Your abstract should also describe the research methods. Typically this would include some mention of the participants involved (the sample), equipment and procedures.

Results: Provide a description of the main study findings, in addition to direct study outputs.

Conclusion: In this section you should provide statements of interpretation and implication of findings. It should not be a simple re-statement of the results. Any important suggestions for relevance to the field or further work that now needs to be carried out can be stated here.

The abstract should be submitted in the format of MS Word (.doc or .docx) document. Keywords should be given leaving one-line space below this text.
